A busy summer lies ahead of us. We will be in youth camps and mission conferences, along with meetings for presenting our work. Will you help us pray that the Lord would continue to open doors for us to share the gospel? We also ask that you help us pray for safety as we travel, our needed support, the remainder of the building materials, a small enclosed trailer, the girls and their families, the faculty and staff, but most of all, discernment and direction so that everything can be done in HIS order, in HIS time and in HIS will.

We were blessed to get to spend some time at our home church with our family and friends in the month of May while working on the home and celebrating SaVannah's high school graduation. She has decided to attend a local college to pursue a degree in elementary education. She will be doing her classes online so she can still travel with us as much as possible. Rachel's first year of home school was a success. She finished the 10<sup>th</sup> grade.
